'Hi Graham. A new website www.antiquestourbridgeglass.co.uk has been launched. It covers the development of Stourbridge, decorative, art glass from circa 1860 to the 1920s, as produced primarily by Stevens & Williams and Thomas Webb & Sons. This wonderfully illustrated site documents the research of its author, acquired over many years as a collector. It is structured to show the various techniques and style of glass produced and presents the original factory records, patents and contemporary publications to illustrate the range of glass designed. Research into the people that made it happen has put some flesh on the bones of the names like Northwood, Carder, O'Fallon, Orchard and many others'.

The website is partially free but also has two levels of paid membership. The premium level provides access to extracts of archive material and Dilwyn has graciously offered to donate a substantial percentage of the £12.00 upgrade fee towards the upkeep of White House Cone museum of glass It will also provide a platform to promote museum activities. So, by subscribing to this site you will also be supporting the new museum.
